

Regulations for the Use of Distribution Boxes and Switch Boxes



Article Overview

Distribution boxes and switch boxes must meet strict mechanical, electrical, and safety standards, including proper materials, installation height, grounding, wiring, and protection devices.

Mechanical and Material Requirements

- **Enclosure Materials:** Steel plates are preferred; insulating plates are acceptable, while wood is not recommended. Steel thickness should be at least 1.5mm for distribution boxes and 2.0mm for power distribution cabinets, with back panels at 3.0mm for structural integrity .
- **Appearance:** Surfaces should be flat, clean, and free of scratches, pits, peeling, or rust. Coatings must be uniform and firmly attached .
- **Mounting:** Fixed boxes should be installed straight and firmly, with vertical distance from the bottom to the ground between 1.3m and 1.5m; mobile boxes between 0.6m and 1.5m. Non-floor-standing boxes require welded mounting lugs for stability .

Installation and Placement

- **Site Selection:** Install in dry, well-ventilated areas, close to the power supply, avoiding humid or corrosive environments .
- **Distance Requirements:** The distance between a distribution box and a switch box should not exceed 30m, and the horizontal distance between a switch box and fixed equipment should not exceed 3m
