Differential Relay	Protects transformers, generators, or busbars	Compares current entering and leaving equipment	Trips breaker if difference exceeds threshold; supervised via auxiliary supply and test circuits ()
Overcurrent Relay	Protects lines and feeders	Operates when current exceeds set value	Can be definite-time or inverse-time; supervision ensures relay operates reliably under act...
