

Requirements for cable tray screws



Article Overview

Cable tray support screws must be selected and installed according to IEC 61537 standards, considering tray width, load, and environmental conditions.

Screw Selection and Standards

Cable tray support screws are used to secure trays and fittings, ensuring mechanical stability and safe cable routing. They must comply with IEC 61537, which governs cable tray systems and ladder systems, ensuring they can handle expected loads, environmental factors, and maintain electrical continuity when required. Screws should be compatible with the tray material (steel, stainless steel, or aluminum) and any corrosion protection applied, such as galvanization or coatings.

Screw Size and Type

- Common screw type: FRS M6 truss-head bolts with combination nuts are recommended for joint plates and tray connections.
- Drill hole diameter: Holes in the tray rail and base should be ≥ 7 mm to accommodate screws and prevent transverse bending under load.
- Number of screws:
 - For a tray side height of 60 mm, use 4 screws per connector.
 - For a tray width of 300 mm, use 3 screws per joint plate. Wider trays (≥ 400 mm) require a joint plate to prevent bending.
