

Requirements for lightning protection measures for computer room power distribution boxes



Article Overview

Power distribution boxes in computer rooms must be protected against lightning-induced surges using a combination of external lightning protection, surge protection devices (SPDs), proper grounding, and bonding in accordance with IEC 62305 and NEC/IT room standards.

External Lightning Protection

Computer rooms should be part of a building-wide lightning protection system (LPS) if the risk assessment indicates potential exposure to lightning strikes. According to IEC 62305, the LPS should include:

- Air termination systems to intercept lightning strikes.
- Down conductors to safely route lightning currents to earth.
- Earth termination systems with low resistance to dissipate energy.
- Bonding and shielding to prevent lightning electromagnetic impulses (LEMP) from affecting internal systems . The LPS design should consider the Lightning Protection Level (LPL I-IV), which determines the expected lightning current and the required protection measures .
