In homes, the best height for installation is about 1. According to the "Code for Acceptance of Construction Quality of Building Electrical Engineering" GB50303-2002, the vertical distance between the bottom surface of the fixed stainless steel enclosure ip67 and the ground should be greater than 1. The bottom surface. Distribution box and switch box should not exceed 30 meters.
