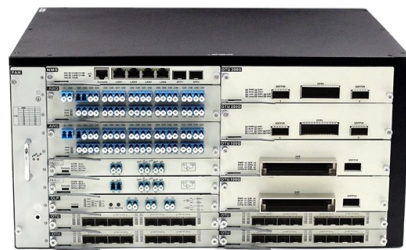


Secondary power distribution wiring in the distribution box

Secondary wiring in a power distribution box carries low-voltage electricity from the distribution transformer to branch circuits, ensuring safe and reliable delivery to end users.

Overview of Secondary Distribution

Secondary distribution refers to the low-voltage network that delivers electricity from a distribution transformer to end-user points such as homes, offices, or industrial equipment, typically operating below 1 kV (e.g., 120/240 V in residential systems) . This stage follows the primary distribution, which carries medium-voltage power from substations to transformers . The secondary system prioritizes safety, reliability, and power quality for consumers .

Components of a Secondary Distribution Box

- Main Circuit Breaker: Protects the entire panel from overloads or short circuits.
- Busbars: Conductors that distribute power to multiple branch circuits.
- Branch Circuit Breakers: Individual breakers for each load or group of loads.
- Neutral and Ground Bars: Provide return paths and safety grounding.
- Wiring Connections: Cables connecting the main breaker to branch breakers and from branch breakers to outgoing circuits .
