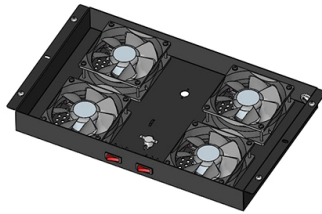


Secondary wiring of the distribution cabinet



Article Overview

Secondary wiring in a distribution cabinet should be connected according to the electrical schematics, with proper routing, labeling, and secure terminal connections to ensure safety and functionality.

Preparation

- **Study the Drawings:** Carefully review electrical schematic diagrams and wiring diagrams to understand the function and position of each component, as well as the routing of wires and connection points .
- **Gather Tools and Materials:** Prepare wire strippers, crimping pliers, screwdrivers, wrenches, multimeters, wires of appropriate specifications, wire number tubes, cold-pressed terminals, cable ties, and insulating tape .
- **Inspect Components:** Check all components inside the cabinet for damage, loose terminals, or functional issues before starting the wiring .

Wiring Procedure

- **Wire Layout:** Begin from the power supply end and route wires according to the schematic. Leave extra length for maintenance and avoid tangled or overly tight wiring .
- **Terminal Connections:** Connect wires to the corresponding terminals of each component. Ensure screws are tightened properly—neither too loose nor over-tightened—to prevent poor contact or damage .
- **Labeling:** Use wire number tubes on both ends of each wire, matching the schematic markings to facilitate future troubleshooting
