- QSFP112: Balances bandwidth, power consumption, and port density, suitable for environments requiring moderate density with efficient thermal management .

- DAC (Direct Attach Copper): Passive, low-cost, low-power, short-distance (120 km .

- ZR Variant: Supports point-to-point 400G transmission up to 120 km, suitable for metro networks .
- ZR+ Variant: Supports regional to long-haul links with multiple amplification sites,...
