

Should cable trays be galvanized or black tubing

Galvanized cable trays are generally preferred over black tubing for durability, corrosion resistance, and long-term safety, especially in moist or outdoor environments.

Material Considerations

Galvanized steel trays are coated with zinc to protect against corrosion. There are two main types: pre-galvanized (PG) and hot-dip galvanized (HDG). PG trays have a thinner zinc coating (12–20 microns) and are suitable for dry indoor environments like offices or clean factories. HDG trays are fully immersed in molten zinc, creating a thicker coating (65–85 microns) that protects against rain, salt air, and harsh outdoor conditions, often lasting over 20 years. The zinc layer also provides sacrificial protection, meaning it corrodes first to protect the steel underneath. Black tubing or uncoated steel is more prone to rust and corrosion, especially in humid or outdoor environments. While it may be cheaper initially, it requires more maintenance and may fail sooner, potentially compromising cable safety and structural integrity.

Environmental Suitability

- Indoor, dry areas: Pre-galvanized trays are sufficient and cost-effective.
- Outdoor or high-moisture areas: Hot-dip galvanized trays are recommended for long-term corrosion resistance.
- Chemical or industrial exposure: Galvanized trays provide better protection again...
