

Standard Requirements for Outdoor Optical Cable Height



Article Overview

Outdoor aerial fiber optic cables typically require pole heights of 10-15 meters depending on urban, suburban, or rural settings, with sag and tension carefully controlled for safety and performance.

Standard Height Guidelines

- Urban Areas: Poles are generally 10-12 meters high, often concrete, with spacing of 25-40 meters between poles .
- Suburban/Rural Areas: Wooden poles are commonly 12-15 meters high, spaced 40-50 meters apart .
- Extreme Environments: Reinforced steel lattice structures may be used with maximum spacing up to 67 meters to withstand ice, wind, and other environmental loads .

Sag and Tension Considerations

- Maintain sag at 1-2% of the span length to accommodate thermal expansion and prevent excessive tension (e.g., a 50-meter span should have 0.5-1 meter sag), .
- Messenger wire tension should be set at 15-20% of its breaking strength to allow for cable expansion and contraction .
- Pulling tension during installation should not exceed 0.5% of the cable's breaking strength to avoid damage
