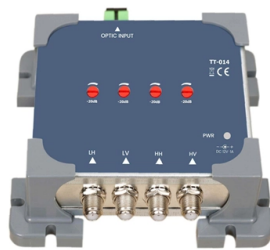


Standard height of mobile power distribution boxes above the ground



Overview

Wall-mounted boxes should be 4. This height makes it easy to reach without bending or stretching. Check and fix the box. The distribution box should be installed in an area close to the power supply to reduce power loss and ensure safety. Avoid installing in a humid and corrosive environment to prevent equipment damage. Check for proper IP/NEMA ratings and material quality. Ensure safe placement: install in dry, accessible areas with good ventilation and at appropriate height (typically ~1. Maintaining this vertical distance protects internal components from. According to the "Code for Acceptance of Construction Quality of Building Electrical Engineering" GB50303-2002, the vertical distance between the bottom surface of the fixed stainless steel enclosure ip67 and the ground should be greater than 1.
