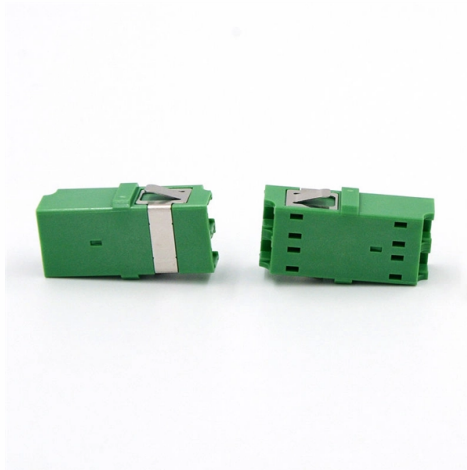

- Rackmount switches: Designed to fit standard 19-inch racks, saving space and improving organization in data centers . Advanced switches may support Layer 3 routing, Open Networking, and modular configurations for high-capacity environments .
