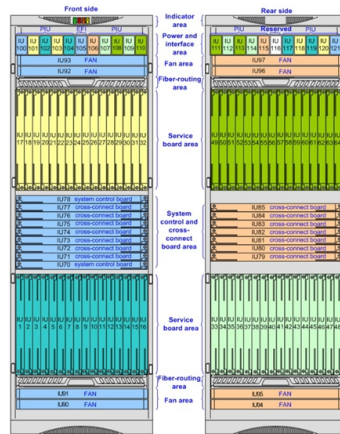


Terminal Box Wiring

It serves as a central hub where incoming and outgoing wires meet, allowing for safe distribution of electricity to various circuits or devices. Terminal boxes protect wires from dust, moisture, and physical damage, and they facilitate troubleshooting, testing, and maintenance without disturbing adjacent connections .

Key Components

- **Terminal Blocks:** Screw, spring-clamp, or push-in connectors where wires are securely attached.
- **DIN Rails:** Metal rails used to mount terminal blocks in industrial setups.
- **Marking Tags:** Labels for identifying circuits and connections.
- **Enclosure:** Plastic or metal box with hinged doors or removable covers for easy access.

- Turn Off Power: Always disconnect the power supply before starting to prevent electric shock
