Purpose and Function

Fiber optic terminal boxes, also called fiber distribution boxes or optical terminal boxes, serve as the termination points for fiber optic cables. They provide a secure and organized environment for connecting the fiber cable to network devices, such as Optical Line Terminals (OLTs), Optical Network Terminals (ONTs), switches, or routers . At each end of a fiber optic cable, a terminal box allows for:

- **Cable Fixing:** The incoming fiber cable is mechanically secured, with grounding and end protection to prevent damage .
- **Fusion Splicing:** Fibers from the main cable are fused with pigtails or other fibers, and the excess fiber is coiled and stored safely .
- **Connection Deployment:** Adapters and connectors inside the box allow flexible insertion and removal of fiber patch cords, enabling easy testing and network configuration .
- **Storage and Management:** The box provides space to store spliced fibers and maintain the minimum bending radius, preventing signal loss or fiber breakage .
