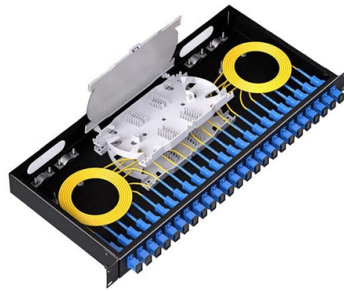

Leaving an electrical distribution box open on a construction site poses serious risks of electric shock, electrocution, fire, and equipment damage, and must be addressed immediately.

Hazards of an Open Electrical Box

An open electrical distribution box exposes live wires and components, creating a high risk of electric shock or electrocution for workers who may accidentally touch energized parts. Even low-voltage circuits (120–240 volts) can deliver currents sufficient to cause serious injury or death, especially if the body provides a low-resistance path to ground due to cuts, moisture, or metal contact . Open boxes also increase the risk of fires, as sparks or short circuits can ignite nearby combustible materials . Additionally, exposed wiring can lead to equipment damage and trip hazards if cables are not properly managed .

Safety Measures

To prevent accidents, construction sites must follow strict temporary electrical installation standards:

- Enclose all distribution boxes with proper covers to prevent accidental contact with live parts .
- Use qualified electricians for installation, inspection, and maintenance of tempora...
