

The earliest proposal of the concept of optical fiber communication



Article Overview

The earliest formal proposal for optical fiber communication was made in 1966 by Charles K. Kao and George Hockham, although foundational experiments date back to the 19th century.

Early Foundations

The concept of guiding light through a medium began in the 1840s when Swiss physicist Jean-Daniel Colladon demonstrated that light could be transmitted through water pipes via total internal reflection, establishing the theoretical basis for optical fibers (Stanford Optics) . In 1870, John Tyndall provided experimental support by showing that light could bend along a water path, further illustrating the principle of light guidance (Stanford Optics) .

Precursor Technologies

In 1880, Alexander Graham Bell and Charles Sumner Tainter developed the Photophone, which transmitted sound on a beam of light over a distance of 213 meters. While not using fibers, the Photophone represented an early attempt to communicate using light, highlighting the potential for optical transmission (Fiberise.com) .
