Overview

Multimode fiber max distance will depend on OM type and data rate. For example when using OM3, or OM4 type fiber 1 GbE max distance will be 550 meters, 10 GbE will be 300 meters (OM3), or 400 meters (OM4), 40G/100 GbE 100 meters (OM3), 150 meters (OM4). 5 μ m and comes with an orange jacket. It uses an LED light source and supports 1Gbps at 850 nm. With a 200 MHz/km bandwidth, OM1 fiber can transmit up to 275 meters for 1 Gigabit Ethernet and 33 meters for 10 Gigabit Ethernet. However, it is more commonly used.
