Physical Hazards

Fiber optic cables contain microscopic glass strands that can easily break during handling. These shards can cause cuts, punctures, or splinters, posing a risk to hands, skin, and eyes if proper precautions are not taken . Workers should wear safety gloves, protective clothing, and eye protection at all times to minimize injury . Additionally, laying cables in outdoor or construction environments introduces tripping, slipping, and equipment-related hazards, requiring careful site management and traffic control .

Optical Hazards

The light transmitted through fiber optics, often in the infrared spectrum (800–1550 nm), is invisible to the naked eye but can damage the retina, cornea, or lens if viewed directly . Even low-power signals can be concentrated enough to cause serious eye injury. Technicians must never look directly into live fibers and should use visual tracers or infrared filters when inspecting fibers .
