

Vertical cable tray support and cable tie



Article Overview

Proper vertical cable tray installation requires secure structural support, correct tray selection, and careful cable tying to ensure safety, organization, and compliance with electrical codes.

Vertical Cable Tray Installation

Tray Selection: Choose the appropriate type of cable tray based on the application and cable types. Ladder trays are ideal for power cables due to excellent ventilation and convenient rungs for cable support, while ventilated troughs are better for smaller control or instrumentation cables that may sag between rungs. Materials such as steel, stainless steel, aluminum, or fiberglass-reinforced plastic (FRP) are selected based on environmental conditions, corrosion resistance, and mechanical load requirements.

Support and Mounting: Vertical trays must be securely anchored to walls, floors, or structural supports. Center-hung or side-mounted supports are commonly used, with maximum support spacing typically around 3.6 meters (12 feet) depending on load capacity. Ensure that the tray is level and aligned to prevent cable stress and maintain proper bend radius at entry and exit points.

Load Considerations: Each support hanger has a maximum load capacity, often ranging from 318 kg (700 lbs) to 340 kg (750 lbs). Proper load distribution prevents sagging and structural failure. Calculate cable fill to avoid overcrowding, which can lead to overheating or mechanical damage.
