

What are the parameters of a fiber optic connector

Key parameters of fiber optic connectors include insertion loss, return loss, ferrule geometry, polishing style, and compliance with IEC standards.

Core Performance Parameters

Insertion Loss (IL): This measures the optical power lost when light passes through a connector, expressed in decibels (dB). Lower IL values indicate better performance, with typical high-quality connectors achieving around 0.1–0.5 dB per connection .

Return Loss (RL): Also called reflection loss, RL quantifies the amount of light reflected back toward the source at the connector interface. Higher RL values are desirable, often exceeding 20 dB for standard connectors and up to 50 dB for high-return-loss (HRL) connectors .

Ferrule Geometry: The ferrule, usually made of zirconia ceramic, aligns the fiber cores. Critical parameters include concentricity, inner diameter (ID), and lateral alignment. Tight tolerances reduce lateral misalignment and ensure minimal optical loss .

Polishing Style: The fiber endface can be polished in different ways to optimize performance:

- PC (Physical Contact): Standard contact with low reflection.
- UPC (Ultra Physical Contact): Enhanced polishing for lower return loss.
- APC (Angled Physical Contact): Angled endface (typically 8°) to minimize back reflection, essential for PON and CATV applications .
