

What does 150 represent in a cable tray



Overview

A rung spacing of 6 to 9 inches (150 to 230 mm) is preferable when the cable tray is intended for instrumentation and control applications that require. It also measures 150 millimeters wide and 50 millimeters high to let you neatly bundle network and audio/video cables. In practice, cable tray dimensions are a system of interrelated measurements —width, depth, length, and material thickness—that directly affect cable fill compliance, heat dissipation, structural loading, and long-term expandability. From an engineering standpoint, cable tray dimensions are not. Standard cable tray widths per IEC 61537 and manufacturers' ranges are typically 50, 75, 100, 150, 200, 225, 300, 400, 450, 500, 600, 750, 900, and 1000mm. Thickness varies by material and load capacity: Galvanized cable tray thickness must meet ASTM A653 standards for corrosion resistance. NEC cable. maintain spacing or to keep cables in place when the tray is bent the minimum bend radius for cables as they exit the bottom of the cable tray.
