White fiber optic cables consist of thin strands of glass or plastic fibers bundled together within a protective sheath, which is then covered by an outer jacket made from materials like PVC, LSZH (Low Smoke Zero Halogen), or Plenum . The white color of the jacket is primarily for easy identification in complex installations and does not indicate a specific fiber type or transmission mode .
