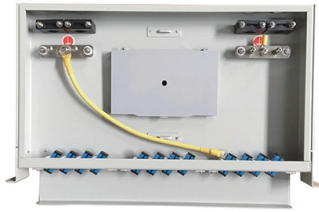


What is the minimum length of cable tray wall



Overview

The 2026 NEC introduced an important update: cable trays must have at least 12 inches of clear vertical space above them to allow for installation and maintenance access. In practice, cable tray dimensions are a system of interrelated measurements—width, depth, length, and material thickness—that directly affect cable fill compliance, heat dissipation, structural loading, and long-term expandability.

Grounding: Metallic trays can serve as equipment grounding. Although BS 7671 touches on the subject of cable supports, it does not detail specifically what these support distances should be.
