A fiber optic cable (frequently shortened to “fiber cable”) is a specialized transmission medium crafted to carry data as light pulses through ultra-thin strands of glass or plastic known as optical fibers. Unlike copper cables, which depend on electrical signals, fiber. There are a wide range of fiber optic cable types, styles, and with different connectors on each end. Generally, single mode cable has a narrow core diameter of 8 to 10 μ m (micrometers), which can propagate at the wavelength of 1310nm and 1550nm.
