Role in Pipeline Infrastructure

Optical fiber cables are not part of the physical pipeline that transports oil or gas; instead, they function as control, monitoring, and communication infrastructure. They are installed along the pipeline route to provide real-time data on flow, pressure, temperature, and vibrations, enabling operators to detect leaks, monitor equipment, and manage pipeline operations efficiently .

Distributed Sensing Applications

Fiber optic cables can act as Distributed Acoustic Sensors (DAS) or Distributed Temperature/Strain Sensors (DTS/DSS). These systems detect subtle vibrations or temperature changes along the pipeline, allowing early identification of potential threats such as leaks, soil shifts, or mechanical stress . The optical fibers themselves are sensitive to environmental changes, and the cable design ensures protection while maintaining sensing accuracy.
