Storage Units for Patch Cords

Fiber optic patch cords require careful handling to prevent bending, kinking, or stress on connectors. Dedicated storage units, such as the 2U aluminum storage unit, are designed to store excess lengths of patch cords safely. These units typically feature multiple compartments (e.g., 24 rooms) and can accommodate cords up to 5 meters in length, mounting conveniently under fiber optic panels like FP70 and FP80 . Using such storage units helps maintain cable integrity and reduces clutter in racks.

Cable Management Best Practices

- Avoid tight bends: Fiber optic cables have a minimum bend radius; exceeding it can cause signal loss or damage.
- Use color-coded pigtailed and patch cords: This simplifies identification and organization, especially in high-density racks .
- Separate by type and length: Store single-mode and multi-mode cables separately, and keep different lengths organized to prevent tangling.
- Label connectors and ports: Clear labeling ensures quick identification and reduces the risk of unplugging the wrong connection....
