

What to do if the optical splitter doesn't have enough optical ports

If there aren't enough optical splitter ports, you can increase capacity by using higher split ratios, cascading splitters, or redesigning the network with centralized or distributed splitting architectures.

Understanding the Issue

Optical splitters divide a single input signal from an Optical Line Terminal (OLT) into multiple outputs for Optical Network Terminals (ONTs). Each splitter has a fixed number of output ports, defined by its split ratio (e.g., 1:8, 1:16, 1:32). If the number of subscribers exceeds the available ports, the network cannot connect all ONTs without additional splitters or reconfiguration.

Solutions to Increase Port Availability

1. Use Higher Split Ratios Increasing the split ratio allows one input fiber to serve more ONTs. For example, moving from a 1:32 to a 1:64 splitter doubles the number of users per port. However, higher split ratios reduce the optical power per ONT, which may require higher-power OLT optics or shorter distances to maintain signal quality . 2. Cascade Splitters Cascading involves connecting multiple splitters in series. For instance, a 1:4 splitter feeding four 1:8 splitters effectively creates a 1:32 distribution. This approach can expand port availability without replacing existing splitters but may introduce additional insertion loss, which must be accounted for in the power budget . 3.
