Overview

Optical Line Terminals (OLTs) use optical modules to convert electrical signals into optical signals for transmission over fiber in Passive Optical Networks (PONs). These modules are critical for connecting the service provider's central office to end-user Optical Network Units (ONUs) or Optical Network Terminals (ONTs) and are classified based on PON technology, form factor, speed, and transmission distance .

Classification by PON Technology

- **GPON Modules:** Support gigabit speeds with downstream rates up to 2.5 Gbps and upstream rates of 1.25 Gbps. They are widely used in FTTH deployments and support triple-play services (voice, data, video) over a single fiber strand .
- **EPON Modules:** Based on IEEE 802.3 standards, these modules transmit Ethernet frames with speeds up to 10 Gbps, suitable for high-speed broadband access .
- **XG-PON / 10G PON Modules:** Designed for next-generation networks, supporting 10 Gbps downstream and 2.5 Gbps upstream, often using XFP or QSFP28 form factors for future-proofing
