OLT optical modules are used in service provider and enterprise networks to convert electrical signals to optical signals, manage multiple subscriber connections, and enable high-speed fiber-optic communication in PON architectures.

Core Usage in Networks

OLT (Optical Line Terminal) modules are primarily deployed at the service provider's endpoint in a passive optical network (PON). They serve as the interface between the provider's core network and multiple end-user devices, such as Optical Network Units (ONUs) or Optical Network Terminals (ONTs), converting electrical signals into optical signals for downstream transmission and vice versa for upstream data. Each OLT port can support multiple ONUs, typically with split ratios ranging from 1:32 to 1:128 depending on the PON standard, allowing a single module to serve dozens or even hundreds of subscribers.

Deployment Scenarios

- Residential Fiber Networks (FTTH/FTTB/FTTC)
- FTTH (Fiber-to-the-Home): OLT modules connect directly to individual homes, providing high-speed internet, voice, and video services.
- FTTB (Fiber-to-the-Building): OLT modules serve multiple users within a building, often in apartments or office complexes.
- FTTC/FTTN (Fiber-to-the-Curb/Neighborhood): OLT modules are placed closer to end-users to optimize signal strength and reduce infrastructure costs.
