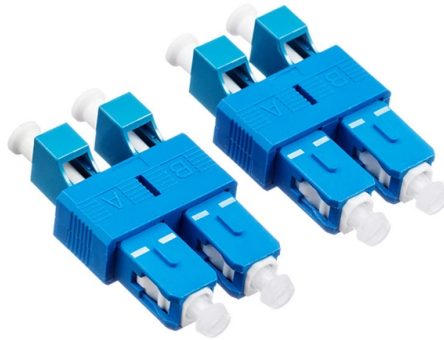


Where are cables laid in conduits and cable trays



Article Overview

Cables should be laid neatly in trays or conduits, following proper spacing, support, and NEC fill rules to ensure safety, heat dissipation, and long-term reliability.

Planning and Preparation

Before laying cables, plan the route according to approved electrical drawings, considering clearance, load capacity, and separation of power and signal cables (). Inspect the site and ensure the cable trays and conduits are free from damage and properly mounted (). Identify each tray or conduit by feeder name and branch number to maintain organization ().

Selecting the Right Tray and Conduit

- Ladder trays are ideal for large power cables, offering ventilation and easy cable entry ().
- Ventilated trough trays support smaller control or instrumentation cables and prevent sagging ().
- Solid-bottom trays protect cables from debris or fluids but require careful ampacity calculations due to reduced heat dissipation ().
- Conduits are used for additional protection or where routing through walls or tight spaces is required ().
