Overhead Installations: Cable trays are frequently mounted above ceilings or suspended from structural supports to route fiber optic cables across large areas. This placement allows easy access for maintenance and expansion while keeping cables organized and out of the way of personnel and equipment . **Underfloor Installations:** In data centers and office buildings with raised floors, fiber optic cables are often routed through cable trays beneath the floor. This protects the cables from physical damage and allows for efficient cooling and cable management . **Vertical Runs:** Fiber optic cables are commonly installed in vertical pathways using cable trays or hangers. Vertical installations are typically done by dropping cables down rather than pulling them up, with proper service loops and hangers to prevent stress and kinking . **Specialized Applications:** Optical fiber trays are also used in industrial facilities, airports, and public buildings where long-distance or high-bandwidth connections are required. In these cases, trays may be installed alongside power cables, but care is taken to avoid mixing fiber with heavier copper cables to prevent mechanical stress .
