

Where do both ends of the MPO fiber optic patch cord connect



Overview

Trunk cables are MPO patch cords that have the same number of fibers and the same type of MPO connectors at both ends. They are used to connect devices and equipment with MPO ports, such as switches, servers, and transceivers. When used for duplex backbone applications, trunk cables with 12-fiber or 24-fiber MPO connectors on both ends form the permanent backbone link, and then transition to either 6 or 12 duplex fiber connectors at patch panels via either MPO-to-LC cassettes or MPO-to-LC hybrid patch cords.

- Type B (Key up-Key up): Full-cross patch cord using a reversed fiber bundle. This design is a stark contrast to traditional.
