

Where is the aggregation switch connected

An aggregation switch is connected between access switches and core switches, consolidating traffic from multiple edge devices before forwarding it to the network core.

Connectivity Overview

An aggregation switch serves as an intermediate layer in a network, often referred to as the distribution or aggregation layer. It is physically connected to all access switches in its domain, which may include wired access switches, wireless access points, or other edge devices, and it forwards traffic upstream to the core switches or routers for high-speed backbone connectivity . This setup allows the aggregation switch to consolidate multiple lower-speed connections into a higher-bandwidth uplink, improving network efficiency and reducing bottlenecks .

Redundancy and High Availability

Aggregation switches are typically deployed in pairs to provide resiliency. Each switch in the pair can connect to the same set of access switches and to the core, often using link aggregation protocols like LACP to combine multiple physical links into a single logical connection . This ensures failover capability if one link or switch fails, maintaining uninterrupted network service .
