Fiber optic cables are spliced to create a continuous optical path, extend network reach, repair damaged cables, and ensure minimal signal loss.

Fiber optic splicing is the process of joining two fiber optic cables end-to-end to establish a seamless optical path for data transmission, which is essential for maintaining high-speed, long-distance communication networks . Splicing is necessary when a single fiber cable is not long enough to cover the required distance, when connecting different types of fiber cables, or when repairing cables that have been accidentally severed . Unlike connectors, splicing provides a permanent, stable joint with very low light loss (attenuation) and minimal back reflection, making it the preferred method for permanent installations .

Methods of Fiber Optic Splicing

There are two primary splicing methods:

- **Fusion Splicing:** This method uses an electric arc to melt and fuse the ends of two fibers, creating a continuous, permanent connection with extremely low signal loss (typically 0.01–0.03 dB). Fusion splicing is ideal for long-haul networks and mission-critical applications due to its reliability and minimal back reflection .
- **Mechanical Splicing:** This method aligns the fiber ends within a small device using an index-matching gel or adhesive to allow light to pass through. Mechanical splices are faster and require less equipment, making them suitable for temporary repairs...
