

Wiring of air switch in dock distribution box



Article Overview

To wire an air switch in a dock distribution box, connect the live, neutral, and earth lines to the appropriate terminals, ensure correct amperage selection, and maintain neat, safe routing of all circuits.

Selecting the Air Switch

- Amperage rating: Choose the air switch based on the load. For general outlets, 16–20A is typical; for high-power appliances like dock lifts or air conditioners, 20–25A may be required .
- Type: Use a double-pole (DP) or 1P+N switch to simultaneously disconnect both live and neutral lines in case of a fault, ensuring safety .
- Circuit separation: High-power devices, kitchen or dock outlets, and lighting circuits should ideally be on separate switches to prevent overload .

Preparing the Distribution Box

- Ensure the box is dry, ventilated, and accessible, typically mounted at around 1.8 meters for easy operation .
- Separate bus bars for live, neutral, and earth should be installed and well-insulated .
- Clean the installation pedestal and ensure there is enough space for the air switch and wiring
