

Wiring of the primary power distribution box at the construction site

Use a five-wire system with proper phase, neutral, and grounding connections, following color codes and load-specific wiring for safe temporary power distribution.

Wiring System Overview

For a construction site, the primary power distribution box typically uses a five-wire system: three-phase lines (A, B, C), one neutral line, and one ground line. Standard color coding is:

- Phase A: Yellow
- Phase B: Green
- Phase C: Red
- Neutral: Light blue
- Ground: Yellow with green stripes .

Incoming and Outgoing Connections

- Incoming line: Connects to the main switch, MCCB, or circuit breaker. Three-phase lines enter the breaker, neutral goes to the neutral terminal block, and ground to the grounding terminal block .
- Outgoing line: Depends on load type:
- 220V single-phase loads: One phase line + neutral + ground
- 380V three-phase loads (motors, heavy machinery): Three-phase lines + ground;...
