

Wiring sequence for a 12-core fiber optic patch panel



Article Overview

A 12-core fiber optic patch panel typically follows a sequential fiber arrangement from 1 to 12, with fibers spliced to pigtails, routed neatly in the splice tray, and color-coded for easy identification.

Fiber Preparation and Splicing

- Strip the incoming cable: Remove the outer jacket of the 12-core fiber cable for about 1 meter and secure the cable using the panel's cable clamp to prevent strain on the fibers .
- Secure the strength members: Attach the cable's strength members to the designated screw or clamp to maintain mechanical stability .
- Route fibers to the splice tray: Carefully guide each fiber into the splice tray, ensuring the bend radius is not less than 37.5 mm to prevent signal loss .
- Splice fibers to pigtails: Each fiber is fusion-spliced to a pre-terminated pigtail. Place the splice sleeve into the slots of the splice tray, with each slot accommodating two splice sleeves .

Fiber Arrangement and Color Coding

- Sequential numbering: Fibers are typically numbered 1 through 12 from left to right or top to bottom, depending on the panel design .
- Standard color code (commonly used for 12-core multimode or single-mode cables):
 - Blue
 - Orange...
