

Working Principle of Manual Door Cold Aisle Machine Room



Article Overview

A manual door cold aisle machine room operates by maintaining a controlled low-temperature environment through a closed-loop refrigeration system, with manual doors designed to minimize air leakage and preserve cooling efficiency.

Refrigeration Cycle

The core of a cold aisle machine room is a vapor compression refrigeration system. The cycle begins when the refrigerant absorbs heat from the air inside the cold aisle via the evaporator, causing it to evaporate into a low-pressure gas. This gas is then compressed by the compressor, increasing its pressure and temperature. The high-pressure, high-temperature gas moves to the condenser, where it releases heat to the external environment and condenses into a liquid. The liquid refrigerant then passes through an expansion valve, dropping in pressure and temperature before returning to the evaporator to repeat the cycle, ensuring continuous cooling of the aisle air .

Airflow and Temperature Control

Inside the cold aisle, fans circulate air to maintain uniform temperature and prevent hotspots. The system typically operates with a thermostat that triggers the compressor to start (cut-in) or stop (cut-out) based on the set temperature range. For example, a cold aisle may be set to maintain 2-6°C, with the compressor cycling on and off to maintain this range
